## Policy Statement

It is the policy of Claflin University to provide a safe learning and work environment for its students, employees, and visitors. -Candles and open flames may create a serious fire hazard.

## Statement of Purpose

This policy is intended to reduce or eliminate the potential threat of a fire or personal injury by the improper use of candles/open flames.

## Applicability

This policy is applicable to students, employees, volunteers and visitors at Claflin University.

## DEFINITION

Open flame devices shall include, but are not limited to, candles, potpourri burners, incense burners and oil lamps.

## Use/Restrictions Regarding Candles/Open Flames

1. Candles/Open Flames: Except as noted in \#2 below, prohibited in University buildings including residence hall and apartments.
2. Religious, cultural, social or honorary groups and/or catered events: Lighted candles which are securely fixed in sturdy, approved candleholders, enclosures, glass hurricane type lamps, etc. are permitted. (Holders and/or other fixtures can be obtained from the Office of Auxiliary Services.) The open flames must be extinguished immediately after the ceremony or function.
3. Food Service Operators (portable cooling equipment): Food warmers must be placed on a non-combustible surface.
4. Laboratories: Excluded from this policy; however, all established safety procedures must be followed.
5. Gas Barbecue Grills: Located outside the building are permitted.
6. Bonfire/burning trash or construction waste: Contact the Director of Auxiliary Services for review/ approval.
7. Pyrotechnics and Open Flame Devices for Special Effects: Contact the Director of Auxiliary Services for review/approval.
